Month	A Child's Right - your right to...	Link to calendar
September	To learn and to go to school (Article 28)	Because it's the start of the school year
October	To say what you think should happen and be listened to (Article 12)	Perhaps to coincide with school council and eco committee elections
November	To not be harmed and be looked after and kept safe (Article 36 + 19)	Bonfire Night, Road Safety Week and Anti-bullying Week
December	To follow your own religion (Article 14)	Christmas and the opportunity to discuss other religious festivals
January	To be the best that you can be (Article 29)	New Year promises and Martin Luther King Day
February	To meet with your friends and join groups and clubs (Article 15)	Valentine's Day / Chinese New Year
March	To a name and nationality (Article 7)	St David's Day
April	To good food and water and to see a doctor if you are ill (Article 24)	World Health Day
May & June	To a good standard of living (Article 27)	Eco Day / Fairtrade Day
July & August	To relax and play (Article 31)	Summer Fun / Sports Day / Fun & Fitness Week
