



Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome back after the Christmas holidays, we hope you had a good break. We thankfully have managed to stay open in this recent cold weather despite teething problems with our boilers. With that in mind, please make sure that your children come to school in appropriate clothing for this time of year. We have some children coming in without coats and lots again in trainers/crocs which are not school uniform.

If you are eligible for Free Schools Meals, the School Essentials Grant covers the costs of uniform and this would have been awarded in readiness for the start of the school year. We encourage parents to apply for Free School Meals as this allows the school to access funding that we can use to help families pay for the costs of trips, interventions etc. If you need more information about this please contact one of the office staff. We know that it is confusing now that every child gets a free school meal but you should still apply if you are eligible.

Free school meals are available to eligible learners who attend school full-time.

This includes:

- younger children who attend nursery provided by a school for full days
- sixth form school pupils

A pupil may be able to receive Free School Meals/School Essentials Grant if their parent receives one or more of the following:

- Income Support.
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance.
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance.
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- Guaranteed element of Pension Credit.
- Universal Credit (as long as the annual net earned household income is less than £7,400, not including benefits).

We have had a complaint from a resident in Aled Avenue of parents parking in the spaces which are for the residents only. Please can you ensure that you do not take up those spaces as they are not for school pick up and drop off. Our neighbours are very accommodating and we don't want to cause any inconvenience to them. We would be grateful for your support with this.
