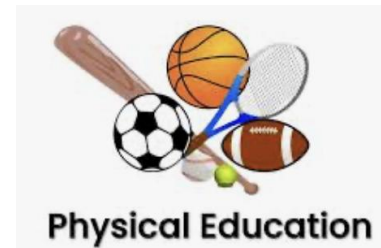

## The School Day

Children will need indoor PE kit (shorts and t-shirt) and outdoor PE kit (leggings/joggers, t-shirt, jumper/hoodie & trainers).



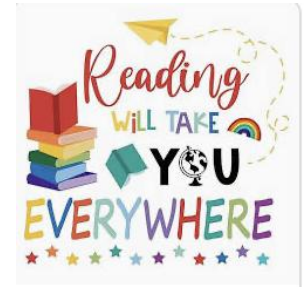
## Snack
