- And lots more!

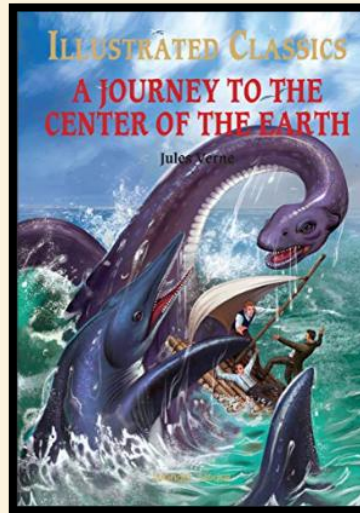
